She also talked about igniting young minds with thoughts of betterment of the nation. She stressed on women empowerment and urged that they also should be given rights as our Constitution gives equality to all its citizens. She recounted real life incidents from her experiences of life and gave examples of women patients who are educated but not given opportunity to take even minor decisions. She asked the younger generation to be aware of many issues like the environment, senior citizens and many diseases.

She further motivated the students that by respecting the rights of others and performing their duties with full sincerity will make relevance to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, given by the United Nations and the related rights, given in the Indian Constitution.

A skit on Human Trafficking was performed by the students of Mount Point School, Matigara Siliguri.

Salesian College students from department of Social Work and Sociology performed a group song

Fr Dr. Saju Puthussery (Vice Principal Arts and Humanities remarked that the day is observed to empower nations to prevent inequality, abuses and discrimination protect the most vulnerable and punish the perpetrators.)




## Day - 4, 17th March 2023

Make My Eyes: World Youth A.I. Object Recognition Programming Workshop cum  
Competition-2022  
Salesian College, Siliguri

Hong Kong Polytechnic University collaborated with Salesian College Siliguri for a 5 Day A.I. Object Recognition Programming Workshop with an aim to improve the lives of the visually impaired by understanding the concept of A.I. and Machine learning and A.I. object recognition technology.

This workshop was held under the guidance of Mr. Tanay Bhadra, The Head of Department of Computer Science and Applications, Salesian College Siliguri. Students from Nirmala Convent School and Auxilium Convent School were invited and trained under different teams combining students of both Hong Kong University and Salesian College.

On the first 5 days of the event the students were taught to use teachable and scratch programming to make their own recognition systems. Then with the help of the volunteers they made their lollipop/noodle recognition hardware by cutting a shoebox, mounting a camera over it and making appropriate arrangements for passing proper light in the box.



The students were also engaged in numerous activities and games which helped in building communication between them and their volunteers/teachers also made them empathize for visually impaired people.



The 5 day workshop was divided into 2 sessions' morning and afternoon where students developed a simple A.I. object recognition systems using Teachable Machine & Scratch.



On the 6<sup>th</sup> day students segregated into teams of 4 used their A.I. object recognition systems build by them. Each team completed a series of tasks blindfolded, to test the system's effectiveness to ease the challenges faced by the visually impaired.

The 5+1 days event was great experience for not only the school students but also for the volunteers. Irrespective of their performance in the final competition, the students thoroughly enjoyed the event, also the volunteers got a massive experience of handling various situations. Some students also left some feedback about their experience with their volunteers.




## Report

### Bamboo Craft Exhibition cum Workshop

Bamboo Crafts Exhibition was held at Salesian College Sonada on March 31, 2023. The event started at 10 AM in the AV Room with the lighting of the lamp, a short prayer was delivered by Fr. Raymond Tudu, and a welcoming speech by Fr. Tomy Augustine in the presence of the chief guest Mr. Anos Thapa, GTA Sabha member of Sonada-Pachang Samesthi.
