
speech of the event was given by Mr. Ravi Bhushan Singh, DoS Literature, Media & Polity, congratulated the students for their preparedness.







This was followed by a speech from our Dean Mr. Patrick Johnson, he encouraged all our students to participate in business quiz events as it will boost their knowledge and confidence in this field.






Report





Siliguri, 29th March 2023: The School of Literature, Media, and Polity organized the 8th edition of Elite Talk. This event has allowed the students to gain insight from the thoughts, ideas, and experiences of a wide range of students while also gaining the knowledge necessary to succeed in their pursuits. The event began at 10:35 am at Marengo Hall. This edition consisted of 14 participants from the Deanery of Sciences, Arts & Humanities, Commerce, Management and Vocational Studies, respectively. The host for the event was Anouska Lama (1st Semester, Department of MCJH), she welcomed everyone. This was followed with an invocation by Fr. Saju Puthusary (VP of Arts & Humanities). He mentioned that “this is the 11th month of the Elite Talk and next month is going to be the first year” and encouraged the speakers to speak confidently. The respected panelists of the event were: Dr. Dipankar Rudra (HOD of Management Studies) Ms. Ronita Chakraborty (HOD and Assistant Professor, Education Department) and Dr. Digvijay Khagra (Assistant Professor, Department of Physics).

The competition aimed to give students to showcase their public speaking and presentational skills. The first speaker Ashmita Moulick (2nd Semester, Commerce Section - B) spoke on the topic ‘Know your Constitution’ where she emphasized the importance of reading the Constitution of the country. Sunil Karketta (6th Semester, Department of Political Science) presented the topic ‘Is there anything greater than Happiness’ where he spoke about the three pillars of life - belongings, purpose, and story-telling. Subhayu Bose (6th Semester, B.Sc. Physics) spoke on the topic ‘The power of being Unflappable’ in which he mentioned how one should be calm in any chaotic circumstances. Siddhanth Subba (6th Semester, Department of History) spoke on the topic ‘Overcoming Fear’ in which he focused that fear does not reflect the truth.

Report

Report: **Students' Seminar Rethinking Hero and Heroism: Exploring Good and Evil in Contemporary Literature and Culture**

Report by Subhradeep Sharma (Department of English, Postgraduate Student)

Day One: April 28, 2023

Salesian College Siliguri organized a seminar on “ Rethinking Hero and Heroism: Exploring Good And Evil In Contemporary Literature and Culture” on April 28 , 2023. The seminar was conducted in two sessions, the opening ceremony and session 1 was conducted in Nazareth Hall and sessions 2 was conducted in Marengo Hall. The programme started at 8:50 am with on invocation by Fr(DR) Saju Puthuserry, Vice Principal, Arts and Humanities. The dignitaries on the dias were Assistant Professor Anik Sarkar, Professor Subhashish Bhattacharjee, Munshi Premchand College, Professor Irshad Ghulam Ahmed.

Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Assistant Professor Anik Sarkar. He highlighted on the overall topic of Rethinking Hero and Heroism. He emphasized on how the hero's journey works as a guide to the common folk. How heroes must return to tell their story. After going through trials and ordeals. Faculty and students from both UG and PG department were invited in seminar.

The keynote address was given by Prof. Subhashish Bhattacharjee, Munshi Premchand College. He shared his research work and talked about how concept of hero and heroism are put into limelight through flims. The theory of how a hero should be and how it observed the changes through the ages.

Mrinal Subba presented the first paper on ‘The Fantasy Of Heroic Purpose: Why do we imitate heroes and how does it actually hinder our heroism?’ Here he talked about how we wish to be superior to others like our heroes. People must be be careful about how much they are trying to imitate their heroes because there is a wide gap between illusion and reality and life is not a hero's journey and we are not living in a fictional story.

Saloni Agarwal presented the second paper on 'Heroes that never are: Journey from the King to the Lions of Mirzapur.' Here she talked about how the obsession of power plays an important role in the development of plot in Indian TV series Mirzapur. Not all heroes come in shining armour, concept of masculinity, shift of power from people to people, female subjugation and even female empowering themselves due to demand of situation are discussed in the paper.

Shagnik Bhakta presented the third paper on 'Metal cover: The Body, the city and Cyberpunk.' Here he talked about how digitalization is the initial step towards progress and technology is the new colonizer of the world. Nations and its dependence on technology and A.I. for its defence. Through Cyberpunk he showed the extreme high and low standard of living of people in the age of technology. Instances from computer games and animes taken to show how technology are used for saving human lives or even to exceed their body limitations by turning them into cyborgs.

Utkrishta Sharma presented the fourth paper on 'Heroism and Korean Culture.' Here she talked about the new face of heroes that carries the difference from being the masculine look of heroes. K-pop is known for their presentations of their skills. Korean films have gained worldwide audience by deviating from the mainstream concept of hero and heroism. K-Pop has contributed to more other than music.

Rituparno Das presented the fifth paper on 'Are stardom and public figures complementary to each other? In his paper he talked about how every public figure does not become a star. There is a difference between stardom and social media influence. Social media followers don't equate with stardom. Celebrities are nation's soft power and the livelihood of many are influenced by the celebrities.

Jasmine Subba presented the sixth paper on 'Service Lamb- Saviour Complex and Extreme Nationalism in Bollyhood.' In her paper she talked about how protagonists in Bollyhood are portrayed. She talked about the films such as Tanhaji and Uri which showed Indian nationalism against foreign powers and terrorism respectively.

Nimeesha Barua presented the seventh paper on 'Eren and the Rumbling.' She talked about the how the ethics of Eren was corrupted when he was blinded by revenge for the wrongs done to him. He was a protagonist with flaws but the audience can justify his actions against Marley due to the brutal realities of his past life. She expressed her views on how the audience can sympathise with characters based on their position of protagonist or antagonist.

Meenakshi Chakraborty presented the eighth paper on 'Indian cinema: Romanticizing Antagonists.' In her paper she talked how Indian cinema presents to its audience a larger than life storytelling. The focal point of paper was how portrayal of antagonists or anti-hero creates an illusion in the minds of the youth, leading them to think that the Wrong is Right. There are instances of reported crimes that were inspired by movies. This irrational way of promoting empathy, normalizing abusive behaviour and increasing tolerance for the wrong is welcoming more unwanted elements in the youth of the nation.

Mimansa Subedi presented the ninth paper on 'Persecuted, Persecution and Heroism in Govinda Rizal's A pardesi in paradise.' In the paper she talked about the brutality faced by minority community in the name of Drukpadization (one nation, one people). How they were forced to leave the nation after giving up their citizenship and enter India as refugees. USA mediated to solve the issue by taking in 70% of the Bhutan refugees and other Scandinavian countries took in refugee samples.

Leena Chhetri presented the tenth paper on 'Analysing the importance of unsung heroes in the society and the psychological influence of animation on the viewers.' In her paper she expressed her views on the positive and negative effect of superhero movies. Not only superheroes protect the common man, but sometimes also resorts to sacrificing them for the greater good. Concept of sacrificing to gain something are visible through such movies. Even though sacrifices are a natural necessity to gain something but should be done in a moralistic way, without much fantasizing, so that the humane nature retains in the result.

Anushka Rathore presented the eleventh paper on 'Victor: The Populace.' Here she talked about how true heroism has been connected with selfless

acts of the people. People such as soldiers, doctors, nurses, farmers etc are real heroes who put true light to the problems of the people.

Wu Chen Kheung presented the twelfth paper on 'Heroism in Western Music.' Here he expressed his views on how western music can be connected to heroism. There were use of music for every scene in plays, dramas and movies and sets the appropriate atmosphere and fills the void. The use of music has been seen from medieval era, renaissance era, classical and baroque era and even before that.

Shraddha Tamang present the last paper for the day on the title 'Hero-Journey of a common man.' Here she talked about how a common man can also become a hero outside reel life. The hero is the man of self-achieved success, a person who has transform himself by eliminating his ego, base desires etc. There is a hero in every man only if he has the ability to polish it and show it to the world.

Finally, the closing remark was done by Mr Loden Lama, assistant professor, department of English.

Day One: April 29, 2023

Salesian College Siliguri organized a seminar on " Rethinking Hero and Heroism: Exploring Good And Evil In Contemporary Literature and Culture" on April 29 , 2023. The seminar was conducted in two sessions, the opening ceremony and the whole session was conducted in Marengo Hall. The programme started at 8:50 am with an invocation by Fr(DR) Saju Puthuserry, Vice Principal, Arts and Humanities. The dignitaries on the dias were Assistant Professor Mr Pema Gyalchen Tamang, Dr Anurima Chanda, Assistant Professor, Birsa Munda College, Assistant Professor Mr Vasudeva Naidu, Assistant Professor & DHoD Ms Pratibha Soni.

Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Assistant Professor Mr Pema Gyalchen Tamang.

The keynote address was given by Dr Anurima Chanda College. She shared her research work and expressed her views on the concept of ultra-hero, nonsense hero. As instances films such as koi Mil Gaya, Krrish were taken. Difference in the ideals in the making of hero in Indian and Western culture, where mind power and physical power plays the important role respectively. Nonsensical elements in children's literature where superhero also serves as a comical purpose.

Aditi Agarwal presented the first paper of the day on ' Understanding the subjectivity of Hero and Heroine: Protagonist vs Antagonist.' Here she talked about how films are breaking the stereotypes of Hero and Heroine. How Heros are portrayed as strong and celebrated character and heroine as helpless glamorous character. Mardaani, fire is talked as an instance that tried to break such stereotypes.

Br Luis Soren presented the second paper on ' Don Bosco: A Modern Hero for the Youth of Today.' In his paper he talked about the life of John Melchior Bosco and how he worked for the welfare of the people. Eight prominent teachings of Don Bosco and his preventive method of teaching. And how drastic situation calls for drastic remedy.

Apeksha Mukhia presented the third paper on 'Indian Cinema: the Good, the Bad and the Ugly.' Here she talked about invisible effect of the films on the youth. As instance, the longest running film in Indian Cinema, Dilwale Dulhaniya Le Jayenge was taken and showed how the stalker character of SRK is celebrated. Many crimes were reported that were inspired by such kind of films where youth feels that it Right or Cool to do what is wrong. Comparison of Indian movies to Western.

Chetan Agarwal presented the forth paper on 'Evolution of Hero and Heroine in Western Culture.' In his paper he talked about the hero journey and the heroes with thousand faces. There is a general pattern in every hero's story (The known, he adventure, and chance to make it right). Evolution of tragic heroes from the Greek origins to Shakespeare's tragic heroes. The English Renaissance Heroes are seen with human qualities (good and bad).

Prabal Rai presented the fifth paper on 'Good to be bad? The Villain as Protagonist (Making the Infamous Famous). In his paper he expressed his views on good and evil and gothic representation of evil. The villain is made due to situations and the choices he is forced to make. For instance in Naruto, Obito was compelled to take the path of vengeance as he was not able to get justice if he followed the path of non-violence. Many series were taken as instances where the villain is the protagonist such as Megamind, Despicable Me, Death Note, The Picture of Dorian Gray.

Tannistha Dutta presented the sixth paper on 'National Hero: Hero of the Nation.' Here she talked about the Revolt of 1857: Crumbling of gender business. Rani Lakshmi Bai who fought till death against the British. Not all heroes carry weapons, some even carry pens. Sarojini Naidu, Kadambini Bose were some of them. Recruitment of women started in Indian army, there is also a regiment in the honour of Rani Lakshmi Bai.

Tisha Singh presented the final paper on 'Good to be Bad? The villain as Protagonist.' In her paper she talked about how Hero is basically someone who saves and villains who destroy. The Chinese symbol of Yin and Yang which shows that there is always some bad in total good and some good in total bad. One of the qualities of seven deadly sins are always found in antagonists.

The best papers from both UG and PG were awarded in which the best presenter from UG was Tisha Singh and the best presenter from PG was Meenakshi Chakraborty. The Awards were given by Fr(prof) George Thadathil, Rector, Salesian college siliguri.

Finally the closing remark was done by Fr(prof) George Thadathil, Rector, Salesian college siliguri and vote of thanks by Mr Peter Lepcha, Dean, Art and Humanities.







Prize distribution took place and Aniket roy captain science team took man of the match and Rohit sahani got the man of the tournament by his outstanding performance.


Father C.M paul addressed at the end and suggested that there should be a women's tournament as well.

He at last declared the tournament to end.



Report on the District Level Tournament held in Kalimpong College



Overall, the entire trip and experience especially for the new students was heart-warming and great bonding session and soon we would have high hopes and great expectation from our college team students.


